

Mastering Feathers on the Machine

Supply List

Design Supplies:

10 sheets plain white paper (copy paper is fine)
2 sheets tracing paper (Sue will have some to share)
2 pieces white paper cut 6' x 24" (apprx. Is fine)
Paper scissors
Pencil and pencil sharpener
Ruler for drawing and measuring
Compass

Sewing Supplies:

Sewing Machine- bring instruction manual, extension bar or table and all accessories.
Don't forget foot pedal and power cord!
Darning foot- A MUST for free motion quilting
(Sue prefers an open toe darning foot)
Straight stitch throat plate- optional, bring if you have one
Twelve 12" squares muslin
Six 12" squares cotton or cotton blend batting
60 safety pins- size 0 or 1
Sewing machine needles- 80/12 & 70/10 sharp (Schmetz brand called microtex sharp) or
75/11 machine quilting
Cotton thread- off white and tan, 50/3 ply, 50/2 ply or 40/3
(I use these brands: Mettler, Aurifil, Superior Masterpiece and King Tut)
Marking pencil- I use Quilters Choice, silver and white
Pencil Sharpener
Rubber Gloves- kitchen dishwashing gloves, one size smaller than you wear for
dishwashing (I use the fingertips for control in free motion quilting)
Basic sewing supplies- scissors or snips, extra bobbins.
Extension cord/multi-plug strip
Optional, but good idea- extra light and cushion for height

"Machine Quilting: A Primer of Techniques" is a companion book for this workshop- not required

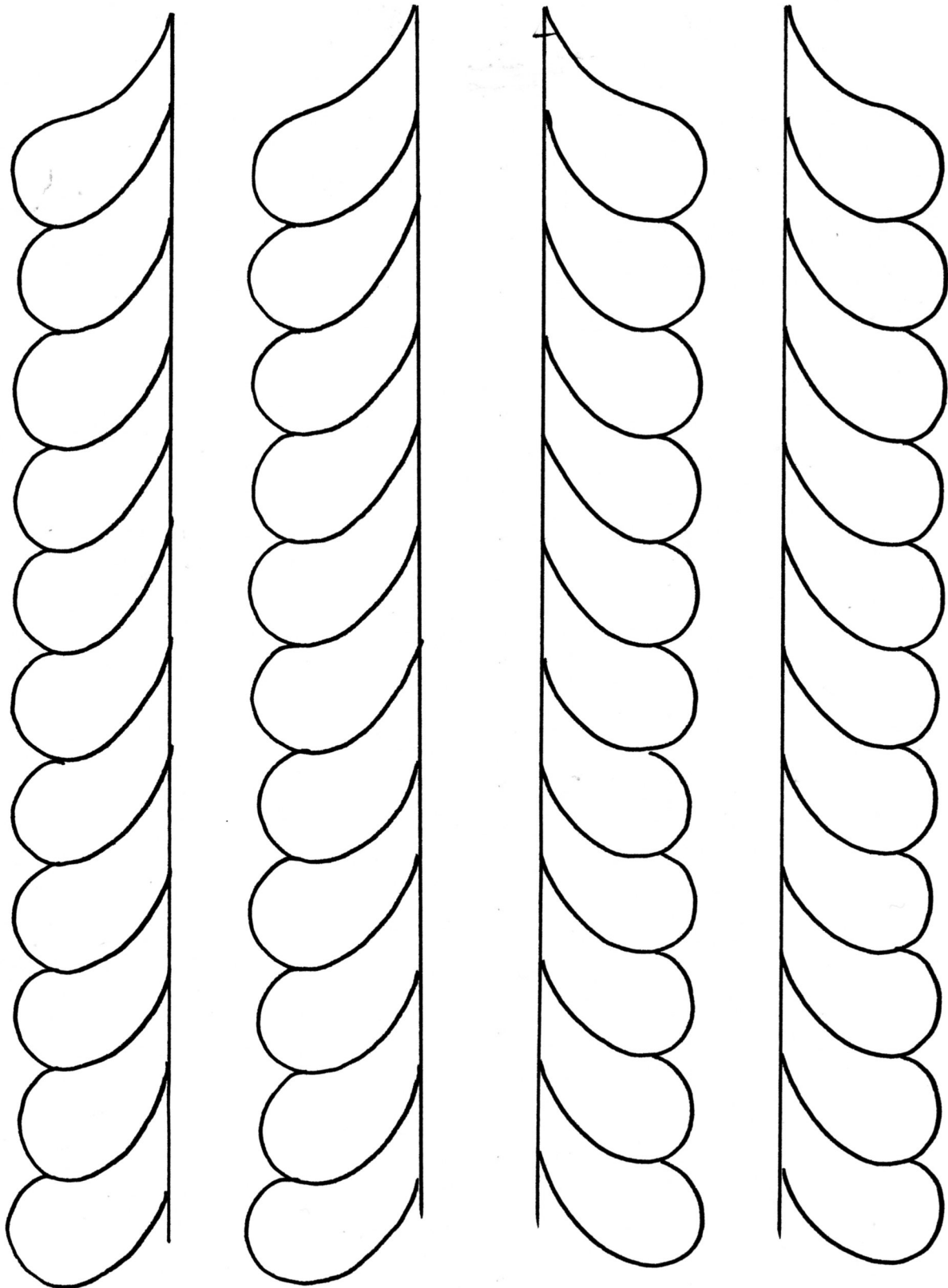
